T19 D4 Strategy Guide

By yours, finally, Fyra.

Gear:



Thorstein shield was at t18. Runes were 3 leg and 1 myth dual strike. Enchants were 5 myth empower and 1 leg lifesteal (learned this trick from BjorneIronside. Cheers!)

Gear adjustments:

I rolled one Aeneas chest piece (can be any of them really) and set it to stamina. I kept it at t18. Also, I had a low power, mid stam, high speed mount for Washibot and Dr Edibles (yum).





Familiar setup:



Teith +4: two myth evade, one leg evade. Heal bonus chip. Epic redirect bone.

Gello +5: One myth deflect, two leg deflect. Increase damage reduction the higher your health is chip. Leg redirect bone.

Blinka +5: One myth damage reduction, two leg damage reduction. Heal bonus chip. Leg Sp generation when at full health.

Strategy:

For mobs: Use very first Aeneas build above. Kill off dps mobs. Moody and some other might occasionally wipe your team since they have shock skills. Give Blinka SP to have her shield your team to max. But don't bother with the shielding if the mobs are all dps.

Bosses:

Ideally, you'll want Dr. Ediblegh first, then Washibot, and then Robosawa, preferably with all the mobs killed. That exact order was what my winning run was. :P

Dr. Ediblegh:

Set for high turn rate Aeneas. Dr. Ed will likely hit Blinka first. May have to pot Blinka. If Dr. Ed is in back, there is a high chance that that first turn will almost take out Dr. Ed (I've seen 250k dbl proc EMPs on him!). Spam 0sp shock strongest to continue the shocks until Dr. Ed is dead. You die yourself from his attack weakest attacks, in which case, you just close the dungeon and eat a donut.

Washibot:

Set for high turn rate Aeneas. I like to move both Gellos to the front after the initial attack—they might deflect a shock hit back onto Washibot! Here you want to just spam 0sp heal or 1sp give SP to Gellos and Blinka (if she is still alive). You want to do this so that they can use non-attack skills during their turns. Hope and beseech the RNG gods to have Washibot near the back and for that massive EMP proc from Aeneas 4/4. On my winning run, I managed not to have to pot any of my tanks. I think a deflect killed Washibot…!

Robosawa: (Robosowwy)

Set for high stamina Aeneas. I did also try for more power, but the higher stam let me have more turns so that I could give my fams SP, heals, etc. Ideally, Robosawa will just have tank fams around him (tanks to take the shock proc and make for viable EMPs). Only use 0sp or give SP skills when available to your fams. Robo or the enemy dps will do an initial attack. On your turn, move both Gellos up front (see if Robo has 1sp — he likes to use the bleed closest two skill). Hope for that deflect! If Robo hits himself with a deflect, then pretty much you can just wait him out; this is what happened on my winning run! And your shock proc will also take him down. Pot tanks as needed. On my winning run, I did use some super pots (when I realized that he was my final boss!).

On the whole, I think I used 4k energy to beat. The first half of that was just figuring out team and gear.
